While it may be challenging to get a large amount of people calling in to create a dynamic prayer line environment at first, just like anything in its infancy, it takes time and commitment to grow. Here are some tips to help attract participants:

- Work with what you have by telling like-minded individuals about your prayer line. Friends, family, churchgoers and bible study groups. Connect through their networks to help broaden yours.
- Promote your prayer line any way you can. Write it on the church calendar. Ask the church leaders to mention it before, after or during weekly sermons. Include it in the

newsletter and discuss it at bible study and Sunday school.

- Make sure the more social and influential members are well-informed.
- Start by setting a few select dates and times where you think members will be able to easily attend. From there you can gauge the next appropriate time slots and who knows, eventually be open 24/7!
- Seek out members to add to your prayer line.
- Use social media. Post pictures, ask for prayer requests, recognize volunteers, share stories, create prayer themes all posted on Facebook or Instagram.

Don't feel discouraged if your prayer line is initially quiet. With a little love and commitment, it will expand and become an integral part of your ministry.

Deciding On Prayer Line Topics

Keep things flowing by having topics and key points thought of ahead of time. This chapter will explain how to brainstorm and select inspiring topics.



Deciding What's On The Agenda

The easiest way to get your prayer line up and running and gaining traction is to choose the topic or person you will pray for in advance. Have these topics written in a list of prayer points to help you to stay on track during your call. Consider sending these points to your audience in advance in your invitations.

Furthermore, having a dedicated topic (see next page) helps to create structure. By designing the meeting around one topic, everyone can chime in. Even though you may veer off course, you're still within the overarching idea.

Consider the following sample itinerary for a meaningful and organized call:

1. Hello And Introduction Of New Participants

Allow everyone to introduce themselves and say a thing or two.

2. Set The Tone With Opening Scripture

Choose a reading that embodies the topic and raises any thoughts or questions.

3. Quick Rundown Of Housekeeping/Etiquette

Go over how to ask questions, interruptions, etc., anything that affects the flow of conversation.

4. Initiate Open Or Structured Prayer

Have everyone come together in unified prayer. Think about whether you want to mute for a quiet, personal moment, or unmute for listening to the group pray together.

5. Pray For Blog Commenters And Other Sources

Address the prayers of those who commented through social media or in-person.

6. Allow Callers To Make Requests

Set aside some time for anyone calling in who needs to make a request or requires support.

7. Closing Scripture And Last Words

End with a small scripture, and any updates or news for next time.

Topics To Discuss On Your Prayer Line

Now that you have a better idea of the flow and set up of your prayer line, here are a few hot topics to help get conversation moving. Announcing the subject matter or theme ahead of time reinforces the discussion. Whether you choose to have more of a conversational approach or group meditation, or solo prayer time, everyone's focus on the same theme will ensure a productive and healing time spent together.

Use these concepts as guiding stars. They are meant to be broad so it is inclusive to many and all participants. They are the perfect starting point to cultivate more intricate and specific stories. And if one topic has a lot of success, then you can drill it down to be more specific next time.

For example, parenting can then become a session for new parents. Conversely, it can also become more niche to grandparents. Think about engaging ways that involve grandparents – reading scriptures about the importance of grandparents; holding a prayer session for grandparents that have passed on or who are sick or who we simply want to dedicate our thoughts and prayer to.

Announcing Your Prayer Line

Once your prayer line is set up, informing future listeners of when and where to attend will determine your success! This chapter outlines how to do this.



Announcing Your Prayer Line

Your church is already a social place. It's where people come to connect with their faith and their community. Consider how social media operates the same way, but stands as a broader platform that can reach out further. By getting your message online within your community, you will be able to kickstart your prayer line listenership with ease. Facebook, for example, allows you to be social by sharing helpful content, like the announcement of your prayer line, recruitment postings for volunteers, video clips for promotion, etc.

Plus, it gives others a platform to comment. This is where people can ask for prayer requests, share personal stories, tag the church, share photos, and could potentially lead to dipping into Facebook advertising for greater results (that's a whole other ebook!).

But, before you jump onto social media, you will need to lock down when your services will be offered. Choosing a time and date that works for everyone will help set you up for success.

Establishing just TWO one-hour sessions per week (one in the am, and one in the pm) will give members the opportunity to join in at their convenience. In return, this will allow you to have a better idea of volume and input so you're able to expand or add in more sessions. Once you have this, you can post online and send out emails with your dial-in information.
